RESOLUTION NO. _____

Re: Authorizing a Public Hearing
Relating to a Moratorium on
Commercial Data Centers in the
Town of Sweden.

WHEREAS the Sweden Town Board is sensitive to the growing demand for Commercial Data Centers developed and/or established in various locations throughout the county, and

WHEREAS the Sweden Town Board is desirous of evaluating the impact of same relating to the Town of Sweden and anticipates that a one (1) year period of time will likely be sufficient to do so , and

WHEREAS a proposed Local Law enacting and imposing a moratorium on Commercial Data Centers has been drafted and is attached hereto, it being the intent of the Sweden Town Board to consider adopting same as soon as legally possible; and

WHEREAS the Sweden Town Board is required to hold a Public Hearing on the matter before enacting said Local Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Sweden Town Board calls a Public Hearing to hear all persons for or against the adoption of a moratorium on Commercial Data Centers in the Town of Sweden on October 13, 2026 at 6:05 p.m. at the Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York, 14420.

Section 2. The Sweden Town Clerk is authorized and directed to cause an appropriate notice of this Public Hearing to be published in the official newspaper of the Town in accordance with Town Law §265.

Section 3. By passage of this Resolution the Sweden Town Board does hereby declare and impose a moratorium relating to the acceptance of any application for the establishment, location and/or operation of a Commercial Data Center in the Town of Sweden until such time as the aforesaid Local Law is duly before the Board for consideration.

Section 4. The moratorium set forth in the previous section hereinabove shall remain intact For no longer that five five (55) days after the date hereof.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

- WHEREAS, the Town of Sweden (hereinafter “local government”) believes that the lack of housing for New York residents of all ages and income levels negatively impacts the future of New York State’s economic growth and community well-being;
- WHEREAS, the housing crisis has negative effects at regional and local levels, we believe that every community must do their part to contribute to housing growth and benefit from the positive impacts a healthy housing market brings to communities;
- WHEREAS, we believe that supporting housing production of all kinds in our community will bring multiple benefits, including increasing housing access and choices for current and future residents, providing integrated accessible housing options that meet the needs of people with sensory and mobility disabilities, bringing economic opportunities and vitality to our communities, and allowing workers at all levels to improve their quality of life through living closer to their employment opportunities;
- WHEREAS, we believe that evidence showing that infill development that reduces sprawl and supports walkable communities has significant environmental and public health benefits; and
- WHEREAS, we believe that affirmatively furthering fair housing and reducing segregation is not only required by law, but is essential for keeping our community strong and vibrant;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

- Sec. 1. That Town of Sweden, in order to take positive steps to alleviate the housing crisis, adopts the Pro-Housing Communities pledge, which will have us endeavor to take the following important steps:
1. Streamlining permitting for multifamily housing, affordable housing, accessible housing, accessory dwelling units, and supportive housing.
 2. Adopting policies that affirmatively further fair housing.
 3. Incorporating regional housing needs into planning decisions.
 4. Increasing development capacity for residential uses.
 5. Enacting policies that encourage a broad range of housing development, including multifamily housing, affordable housing, accessible housing, accessory dwelling units, and supportive housing.

- Sec. 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
