TO INCREASE CHIPS FUNDING AND EXPENDITURE APPROPRIATION IN THE 2025 BUDGET

- WHEREAS, the Town of Sweden receives Consolidated Local Street and Highway

- WHEREAS on November 12, 2025 a notice having been served upon the abovenamed subject property owner pursuant to Sweden Town Code Chapter 54 and said notice was also filed in the Monroe County Clerk's Office; and
- WHEREAS on November 25, 2025 a Hearing was held at the Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York, at which time all individuals in relationship to this matter were heard.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:
