

LOCAL LAW 1 OF 2026 AMENDING
SWEDEN TOWN CODE CHAPTER 64
BUILDING CODE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

Be it enacted by the Sweden Town Board, County of Monroe, State of New York (hereinafter referred to as the Board), as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE (§64-1)

This Local Law shall be referred to as "Local Law #1 of 2026 Amending Chapter 64 of the Sweden Town Code Concerning Building Code Administration and Enforcement".

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION (§64-2)

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the New York State Constitution Article IX, Town Law §261-264 and Municipal Home Rule Law §10.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND INTENT (§64-3)

This Local Law is adopted to pluralize the definition of Code Enforcement Officer in Chapter 64-1 Definitions of the Sweden Town Code, and to revise all corresponding references throughout Chapter 64 from the singular to the plural form to accurately reflect current administrative structure.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 64-1 DEFINITIONS

Sweden Town Code Section 64(1) is hereby changed to the following:
CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS: The Code Enforcement Officers or such other persons appointed by the Town Board to enforce the provisions of this chapter.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY AND/OR VALIDITY (§64-5)

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law, or the application thereof to any person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its

operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Law, or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which said order or judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE (§64-6)

This Local Law shall take effect upon the date it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law §27.
